1. What are the available elective positions?

- National Treasurer and 1 position
- Governing Council positions 4 positions

4. Which category of members are eligible to vote?

Answer:

Those eligible to vote are Fellows, Honorary Fellows, Honorary Senior Members and Associates of the Institute.

5. As a member, what do I need to do to be able to vote?

Answer:

To qualify to vote, members shall be financially up to date in the payment of 2024 Annual Subscriptions, levies etc. on or before **March 8, 2024**.

6. How do I check my Financial Status?
